Timetoast is a programme to make a timeline indicating the time when an event took place, details about the event and photos

1. Timetoast usage

2. Things you need to do before using the programme Timetoast

Each group is responsible for one period of migration

a) From the results of the survey that we made with the street interviews gather the people according to their immigration period:

1850 – 1899 Group 1
1900 – 1945 Group 2
1946 – 1989 Group 3
1990 – 2014 Group 4
2015 – 2019 Group 5
```

- b) Select a photo for your period by either taking the photo of a person you interviewed (that arrived in your period if possible) and convert it into a black and white photo Name of file: group1, group2, group3, group4, group5
- c) Think about a description for your period of migration Make two documents:
 - Historical background of period: check on the Internet what was going on in Germany and/or in the home countries at that time

Name of file: e.g. group1-timespan

- Event: add numbers from the interviews concerning the number of migrants and countries they came from, things you remember from what people told you during the interview Name of file: e.g.group1-event
- d) Upload your 3 materials to Twinspace
